1.	Wednesday, Nov. 9th	Using the "Adjective Bank" write 10 sentences with 3 adjectives each. Remember to put the adjectives in the correct order.
2.	Thursday, Nov. 10th	Expo. By this date, your questioner has to be fully completed. // Study adjectives for quiz.
3.	Wednesday, Nov. 16th	Using the info from your questioner, do a mental map (with drawings and images) about your country for the expo
4.	Thursday, Nov. 17th	Study Spelling #1, #2 and #3 for spelling quiz and spelling bee
5.	Monday, Nov. 21st	Write a paragraph (6 to 10 sentences) telling a short story or describing an event. Try to use at least 5 adverbs. (Underline them)
6.	Thursday, Nov. 24th	Each team has to present their plan and working schedule for the Expo. Give details on the exact things you are going to do, and list and explain the steps you will follow to accomplish them.

After reading the story "Tales From The Odyssey", imagine that you are one of the people who live on the island, or one of Odysseus crew men and tell the end of the story from your point of view (1st person) instead of Odysseus' (3 rd person)
8.	Thursday, Dec. 1st	Together with your team, write as many paragraphs as necessary presenting the information for your exposition. Please highlight and label who will say each part. Everyone needs to have the complete presentation on their notebook.
9.	Monday, Dec. 5th	Bring material (glue, scissors, magazines to cut out, images, colors, markers, colored paper...) to work on team expositions. Topic: Early Explorers
